Dr. Melodie Galloway new Musical Director of Junaluska Singers

Dr. Galloway holds a Master's degree from Florida State University in Vocal Performance and a Doctor of Musical Arts in Conducting from the University of Greensboro. Her experience as a conductor and soprano soloist includes opera, music theatre, and a professional vocal ensemble, with which she has been a soloist in Russia, Estonia, Ireland, England, Spain, and for former Presidents Bush and Clinton as part of the White House Christmas celebrations.
