Wayne holds an M. Div. and Ph.D. in theology from Emory University. He has taught at the Episcopal seminary at Sewanee, TN, and later was for eight years a Visiting Professor of Anglican Studies at the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia. He also has taught biblical studies, Judaic studies, and religion and modern culture at Dickinson College.

Dr. Floyd is a well-known scholar of the theology of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, and served from 1993-2004 as the General Editor of the 16-volume English critical edition, *Dietrich Bonhoeffer Works*. He has written two books, edited two others, and has written numerous articles for book compilations and for journals such as *The Christian Century*, *Religious Studies Review*, *Dialog*, *Journal of the American Academy of Religion*, and *Modern Theology*.
