Accommodations and Meals

Participants are responsible for making their own housing arrangements.

Make your lodging reservations directly with Lake Junaluska Conference and Retreat Center. Rates vary depending on location and range from \$90 per day (per person double occupancy including three meals a day) to \$41 per day (per person double occupancy dormitory style lodging without meals).
