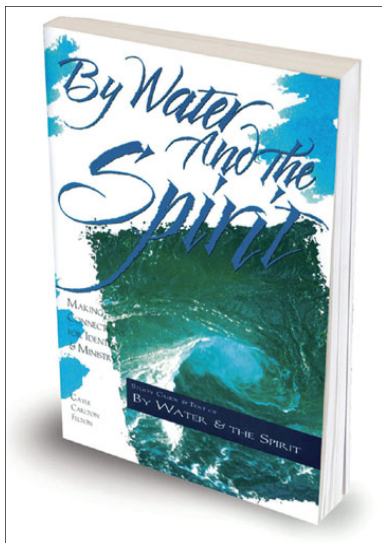


This study edition is designed for use in the work of teaching and learning from “This Holy Mystery.” It is organized into seven sessions but is flexible enough to be utilized differently and could easily be expanded into twice as many sessions. Each session contains four types of material: the text of “This Holy Mystery,” approved by the 2004 General Conference; commentary on the section of text used in that session; general suggestions for “Teaching and Learning”; a section entitled “To Expand the Study” that includes suggestions and resources particularly relevant to clergy and for use in academic settings. Much fine material on Holy Communion by outstanding scholars has previously been published, and there are specific recommendations to facilitate finding and utilizing those resources, which are integral to the study.

Gayle, an elder in the North Carolina Annual Conference, is the author of two official UM studies on the sacraments for United Methodists – **BY WATER AND THE SPIRIT** (1997) and **THIS HOLY MYSTERY** (2007). Dr. Felton

has served on the faculty of DUKE Divinity School, as well as Meredith College, and now serves as adjunct faculty at Garrett-Evangelical Seminary. She has spoken and presented across the UM connection in thirty-six annual conferences.

This timely seminar on the United Methodist sacraments – Baptism and Communion – will provide Clergy and Laity alike with an exploration of the primary Means of Grace in the Christian tradition. In recent years, all of the mainline Christian denominations have given renewed study and theological reflection on the sacraments of the Church.

This seminar will span the theological and practical considerations of the sacraments in the spiritual journey of persons and congregations from the United Methodist perspective.

The seminar concludes on Sunday, July 26 with a teaching service of Word and Table—Dr. Felton preacher, and presiding at Table.
