### PROGRAM, ACTIVITY, AND LODGING PACKAGE

## **PAYMENT, ROOMING, AND CANCELLATION POLICIES**

**Deposit & Payment Policy:** A \$60 per person deposit is required to reserve your space. The remaining balance is due 15 days before arrival along with the rooming list. Lake Junaluska requires a credit card at check in that will be authorized in the amount of \$200.00 to cover damage/excessive cleaning/guest dissatisfaction. The authorization of funds will be released within 3 to 10 business days depending on your bank, if there are no damage/excessive cleaning/guest dissatisfaction charges.

**Method of Payment:** Make checks payable to: Lake Junaluska Assembly. Checks are accepted if received at least 15 days prior to arrival. Payments received less than 14 days prior to arrival must be by certified check, money order, cash or credit card. We accept Visa, Master card, Discover and American Express. Please call 800-222-4930 with credit card number and security code to make a payment by card.

**Cancellation Policy:** Program Only and lodging cancellations made 15 days or greater from the first event night receive a full refund minus \$30 per person processing fee. Cancellation 8 to 14 days prior to the first event night will forfeit 50% of total package per person. Cancellations made 0 to 7 day prior to first night of the event will not receive a refund.

## **ADDITIONAL PACKAGE INFORMATION**

**Whitewater Rafting:** Costs are not included in the program fee, but can be added on to your Lake Junaluska Youth Event package at a discounted rate. More information is included in the packet emailed after your deposit is received.

**Mission Work:** Included with Mission Week. For July 15-19, we offer mission opportunities for Lodging and Program Package Guests from 2-4 p.m. on July 16. Registration by the deadline is required and an additional \$13 per person fee applies. Fees are nonrefundable based on the initial registration number. Groups may add participants, on a case by case basis, as needed. **Space is limited.**

**Family Group/T-shirt Size Form:** Every participant is assigned to a middle school, high school or adult Family Group that meets four times for Bible study, fellowship and fun. You will receive a Family Group form after registering asking for the names, ages and T-shirt sizes of all participants. Each group is asked to designate two adults (per 15 youth) who can assist with Family Groups to help maintain a two-adult "Safe Sanctuaries" policy.
